Maayan Koschitzky tapped into the wealth of Napa Valley, precisely selecting fruit from the well-drained soils of Oakville, St. Helena, and Coombsville.

His goal was to capture the essence of 2019 – a long, warm summer with frequent foggy mornings set the stage for our expressive wine. The mild finish to the season allowed for abundant hang time, contributing great color, structure, and soft tannins as the reward.

A wine impeccably balanced with refined tannins and dark fruit notes of blackberry and ripe plum, our Simon Family Estate Cabernet Sauvignon is Napa Valley at its best. Acidity brings a vibrancy to the palate supported with a well-structured foundation, giving the wine a multifaceted, layering sensation. Aged in 70% new French oak, it's a wine with versatility, equally enjoyed young or over the next 15 years.
