2019 SAUVIGNON BLANC • RUTHERFORD, NAPA VALLEY

The pale gold color of our Sauvignon Blanc, earthy yet vibrant, inspired the name Golden Ore. A product of the earth and its environment, it too is a rare find, with only a limited number of cases produced. The vineyard is located on an alluvial fan at the base of the Mayacamas mountain range. Composed of coarse, mostly gravelly soil, this winning combination provides excellent drainage, forcing roots to permeate deep into the ground. The result is a style that develops great structure, complexity, and nuance.

Mastered through years of experience, Maayan Koschitzky followed his intuition to use traditional methods, crafting Golden Ore to live up to its distinguished name.

Fresh and acid driven, Golden Ore has great volume, texture, and tension. The nose is super expressive with notes of apricot, white flowers, citrus, and lemon zest. The palate is racy and vibrant, with hints of citrus, pomelo, lemon pill, accentuated with a touch of vanilla from aging in French oak. The robust foundation, heightened with a vibrant acidity, delivers a wine that cuts through with crispness, and finishes long with elegance.
